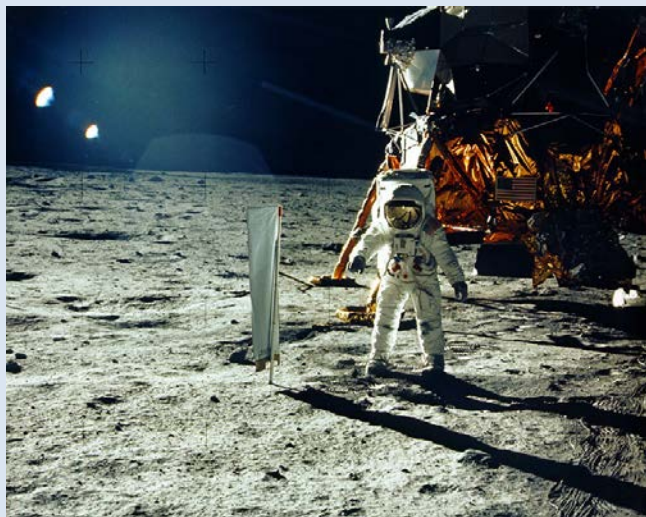


Neil Armstrong, The First Person on the Moon
